**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on **Tuesday, June 25, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.**, the Guam Economic Development Authority (“GEDA”) will hold a public hearing on behalf of the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam (the “Authority”) at the offices of GEDA **located at the ITC Building, 590 South Marine Corps Drive, Suite 511, Tamuning, Guam**, to consider the following:

**ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS**

GEDA will conduct a public hearing on behalf of the Authority as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, at which it will hear and consider information concerning the proposed plan of financing with respect to the issuance by the Authority of one or more series of revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$255,000,000 (the “Bonds”). The Bonds will be part of a plan of finance, which may occur over a period of multiple years.

Proceeds of the Bonds are expected to be used (i) to finance and/or refinance the costs of certain capital improvements to the A. B. Won Pat International Airport terminal, located at 355 Chalan Pasaheru, Route 10A, Tamuning, Guam 96931, and vicinity, including but not limited to the renovation and expansion of the terminal building, including energy efficiency improvements, construction of an international arrivals corridor, seismic upgrades, and construction of an interisland passenger facility; construction of additional aircraft parking aprons; and improvements to access roads and vehicular parking facilities; (ii) to fund a reserve fund with respect to the Bonds; and (iii) to pay certain costs of issuance with respect to the Bonds (collectively, the “Project”).

All financed and refinanced assets are currently owned and/or expected to be owned and operated by or on behalf of the Authority.

Information regarding the Project may be obtained in the office of GEDA specified above. All interested persons are invited to present their views and comments on this matter.

GEDA and the Authority encourage interested parties to attend public meetings and comment on the issues being discussed. If you wish to provide testimony and are unable to attend the meeting, written comments that are delivered prior to the time of the hearing to the office of the Authority specified above will be made a part of the public record.
